Dear Native Trading Corp.:

This document is provided to confirm the compliance and certification of products produced, processed and handled in accordance to Texas state law under the Texas Department of Agriculture's Organic Standards and Certification, Texas Administrative Code, Title 4, Chapter 18 and in accordance with federal law under the National Organic Program, 7 CFR Part 205.

A farm or field unit which has met a strict three-year period from the last application of any material classified as prohibited, including completion and verification of all additional organic production standards, may be certified organic and sold under the Texas Department of Agriculture's Organically Produced logo and certification. However, any farm or field unit which complies with all TDA organic standards, yet has not met the strict three-year requirement and has met at least a one-year period from the last application of a prohibited material, is certified transitional and may be sold under the Texas Department of Agriculture's Transitional logo and certification.

Also, all processors and distributors of organic and transitional products from either in-state or out-of-state sources must be certified and comply to TDA's organic processing and handling standards.
